

SOGS SEED POTATOES 2026: HOW TO CHOOSE AND PAY

- 1. Seed potatoes are set out in the centre of the main hall.
Volunteers are on hand to advise you if needed.**
- 2. The seed potatoes are arranged in 'seasonal' order, i.e.
First Early, Second Early, Main Crop.
Organic varieties are marked with (O).
Further information about each variety is shown on the
large charts in the hall.**
- 3. Put each variety of your choice into a paper bag.
Write on each bag the variety name and the number of the
tubers.
(It's easier to do this before you fill the bag. Pens are
provided. There are larger bags available to put your small
bags into if needed.)**
- 4. When you have finished choosing, pay at the cash desk.
We can accept CARD, CASH or CHEQUE. .**

**Tell the cashier the total number of tubers you have.
Tubers cost 25p each (or 10p each if you are a SOGS
member).**

**You can join SOGS on the day (£12 per person) and get the
cheaper rate!**
